Solicitation No. 17-034– Addendum #1

This Addendum #1 to SRTA Solicitation No. 17-034 is being issued in accordance with Part 1, Section 3.6 of the Request for Qualified Contractors document. SRTA Solicitation No. 17-034 is hereby amended as follows:

PART 1-SOLICITATION OFFER AND AWARD

- Section 9.0 List of RFQC Attachments has been updated to reflect that Offer Document #A7 is the Statement of Responsibility Certification.

PART 3-SCOPE OF SERVICES

- Page 6 has been updated to include the following heading for Section C: Relevant Project Experience.

CONFLICTS OF INTEREST

In order to address potential conflicts, the following shall apply:

- It is deemed a conflict if the proposer as a prime or sub will or could provide a T&R study for GDOT related to any tolled facilities in the State of Georgia.
- A proposer may be eligible if the proposer as a subcontractor to a GDOT consultant (such as a GEC or PMC) performing non T&R services related to any road on which SRTA seeks the T&R Consultant to prepare a T&R study, if the proposer can demonstrate to the satisfaction of SRTA that acceptable safeguards will be implemented and maintained to prevent any communication or sharing of work product between the T&R Consultant's resources working for the GDOT consultant and those providing T&R services to SRTA.
- The proposer may be eligible to perform T&R services or other work as a team member of a proposing entity on projects on which the T&R Consultant performed services under this solicitation, if prior to the performance of such services for the proposing entity, the T&R Consultant shall notify SRTA and GDOT in writing of the matter and request SRTA and GDOT approval to proceed in both roles on the project. In order to be considered for approval the T&R Consultant must demonstrate to the satisfaction of GDOT and SRTA that acceptable safeguards will be implemented and maintained to prevent any communications or sharing of work product between the resources working under this solicitation and those providing services to the proposing entity.

Failure to adhere to these provisions or any other governing ethics or conflict of interest requirements may result in the T&R Consultant and/or the proposing entity (or their proposal) being disqualified or ineligible for award.
