



**SRTA Solicitation No. 17-034
RFP for Traffic and Revenue Consulting Services
January 11, 2017**

Question #1: We are a sub-consultant for a GDOT Innovative Delivery GEC Contract- RFQ 484-103014 Contract #2 (GEC). Stantec had cleared our participation on this contract with SRTA at the time. Stantec has not performed any work on this contract. Is performing traffic and revenue for this assignment a conflict of interest? If so would withdrawal from the contract remove the conflict? (*Section 5.0 Mandatory Requirements, Item 5.0.4*)

Answer #1: Yes, this would be considered a conflict. However, if your firm were to withdraw from the contract, this would remove the conflict. For additional information on conflicts of interest, please see Addendum No. 1 to the RFP.

Question #2: A large annual Toll Road Conference, Texas Forum, is being held in Austin Texas between February 5th and February 7th. Can the interview date for shortlisted firms be moved to either Feb 8 or 9? (*Section 2.0 Schedule of Events, Item Interview Date*)

Answer #2: Yes, we can move the interviews. Interviews will take place on February 10, 2017.

Question #3: What is the Title of section C? (*Part 3 Scope of Services, Page 6, Section C*)

Answer #3: The title is Relevant Project Experience. Please see Addendum No. 1 to the RFP.

Question #4: While our firm is not currently engaged in a contractual agreement, we are part of a team that was just selected by GDOT to Provide Program Management Consultant Engineering Services for the Office of Innovative Delivery (GDOT RFQ-484-091616); the team is not yet under contract but negotiations will start soon. SDG's role on the team would be to provide "Traffic and revenue studies, Level 1 and 2". Do you consider this a conflict per the terms of section 5.1?

Question #5: According to the RFQC, Attachment A7 should be Certification Regarding Lobbying, and it is also listed in Part 3 as such. The A7 Attached to the RFQC is Statement of Responsibility Certification, which is not related to lobbying. It's more related to the Required Documentation we provide for Section F. Please clarify.

Question #6: Can a consultant include a one page cover letter to address 5.0 Mandatory Requirements included in the RFQC?
